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EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.
Spill or leak	Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self contained breathing apparatus. Extinguish warehouse fires with foam, dry powder, CO ₂ or water spray. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed packs with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. Rinse mouth.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention.
If on Skin:	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do NOT scrub the skin. Wash clothing before reuse. If irritation persists get medical attention.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, in a cool, well ventilated area out of direct sunlight and away from food, feedstuffs, animals and fertilisers. Avoid temperatures below -10°C and above 40°C.

AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current standard NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals or the HSNO Regulations.
