Tanker/Vehicle Accident	١	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.							
Spill or leak		Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal							d collect
Fire		Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self contained breathing apparatus. Extinguish warehouse fires with water spray, foam, dry extinguishing media or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed containers with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.							
FIRST AID									
If Swallowed:		Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. Rinse mouth.							
If in Eyes:		Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention.							
If on Skin:		If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly with soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin. Wash clothing before reuse.							
If Inhaled:	_	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.
