Tanker/Vehicle Accident		Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.										
Spill or leak	with suit water pl	Use personal protective clothing. Avoid contact with the skin, eyes, and clothing. Prevent further spillage. Collect spillage with suitable absorbent material (e.g. sand, sawdust, general-purpose binder, kieselguhr). Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings. Place spilled product and absorbed material in a sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.										
Fire	water sp fire, toxion water se	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish warehouse fires with water spray, dry powder, foam, carbon dioxide. Keep containers cool by spraying with water if exposed to fire. During a fire, toxic fumes may be released. Keep non-involved persons away. Contain run-off. Collect contaminated extinguishing water separately, do not allow to reach sewage or effluent systems. Dispose of fire debris and contaminated extinguishing water in accordance with official regulations.										
FIRST AID												
If Swallowed:		Do not induce vomit. Immediately rinse mouth and then drink 200-300 ml of water, seek medical attention. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor.										
If in Eyes:		Wash affected eyes for at least 15 minutes under running water with eyelids held open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do.										
If on Skin:	Remove	Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin.										
If Inhaled:		Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.

Storage : Store in the closed, original container, out of direct sunlight in a locked-up, dry, well-ventilated area, building or room, as cool as possible, away from children, animals, feed or foodstuffs.
