Spill or leak	unconta Avoid ra	Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, full frame goggles and dust mask. Prevent further spillage. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Shovel or sweep up spilled material and place in sealable container labelled for disposal. Avoid raising dust. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material. Seek expert advice from the local authority regarding disposal.									
Fire	fumes n	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water fog, foam or dry chemical. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.									
FIRST AID											
If Swallowed:		Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. Rinse mouth.									
If in Eyes:		Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention.									
If on Skin:		Remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do NOT scrub the skin. If skin irritation occurs, get medical advice/attention.									
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.										
STORAGE AND SEGREGATION											
Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, in a cool, well ventilated area away from food, feedstuffs, animals, and fertilisers. Do NOT store in direct sunlight.
