Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111. Accident Spill or leak Wear overalls, gloves and goggles. Prevent further spillage. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Shovel or sweep up spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Avoid dust formation. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic Fire fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water fog, dry powder, carbon dioxide or foam. Contain runoff. Keep noninvolved persons away. **FIRST AID** Do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 If Swallowed: 766) or a doctor. If in Eves: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin. If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. STORAGE AND SEGREGATION Storage: Store in the closed, original container, in a well-ventilated area, as cool as possible. Protect against moisture. Keep away from heat. Protect from direct sunlight.
