**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 944 955**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Wear overalls, suitable gloves, footwear and safety goggles or face mask. Prevent further spillage and product from entering waterways. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Take up spilled product with a suitable absorbent and place in sealable container labelled for disposal. Wash down affected area with water and detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water fog, dry powder, carbon dioxide or foam. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Immediately rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. <b>For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.</b>
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes with eyelids held open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do NOT scrub the skin. Wash clothing before reuse. If irritation persists get medical attention.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION**

**Storage:** Store in original container, tightly closed, in a cool, well ventilated area away from food, feedstuffs, animals, or fertilisers. Keep away from heat. Protect from direct sunlight

**AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS:** When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current standard NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals or the HSNO Regulations.

**Segregation:** In store separate by at least 5 metres, on transport separate by at least 3 metres, in both cases horizontally. On vehicles a segregation device may be used: Check the Land Transport Rule Dangerous Goods, Rule 45001 for additional information. Sea transport may require additional segregation. Refer to NZS5433 Sea Segregation for details.
