EMERGENCY PROCEDURES **24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 944 955**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.
Spill or leak	Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, full frame goggles and dust mask. Prevent further spillage. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Shovel or sweep up spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water spray, foam, dry powder or CO ₂ . Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately rinse mouth and then drink 200-300 ml of water, seek medical attention. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention.
If on Skin:	Remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do NOT scrub the skin. If skin irritation or rash occurs, get medical advice/attention.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If experiencing respiratory symptoms contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, in a cool, well ventilated area away from food, feedstuffs, animals, or fertilisers. Do NOT store in direct sunlight. Avoid temperatures below 0°C and above 40°C.

AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current standard NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals or the HSNO Regulations.
