GENERAL INFORMATION

Revystar Fungicide is a broad spectrum contact and systemic fungicide with protectant and eradicant activity. It is taken up via the stem and foliage and is translocated upwards and outwards to provide some protection of new growth. Thorough coverage of the crop is necessary for best results. Revystar Fungicide has curative activity against early stages of infection, but optimum results are obtained from application prior to the onset of infection.

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Revystar Fungicide contains mefentrifluconazole, a triazole fungicide from the DMI (demethylation inhibitors) mode of action group GROUP **3** FUNGICIDE, and fluxapyroxad, a carboxamide fungicide from the SDHI (succinate dehydrogenase inhibitors) mode of action group GROUP **7** FUNGICIDE. Resistance to these fungicides could develop from excessive use. To minimize this risk, use strictly in accordance with label instructions and resistance management strategies that exist for any fungus listed on the label. Frequency of application must be strictly adhered to in accordance with the Directions for Use. Revystar Fungicide should be used in a programme that incorporates fungicides with different modes of action to that of Group 3 and Group 7 fungicides. Apply no more than two Revystar Fungicide sprays per season. Refer to the NZCPR web site < www.resistance.nzpps.org > for more detailed information.

Otherwise, apply at the first appearance of disease. Continued disease pressure or reinfection may require a further treatment 3 to 5 weeks later. Apply up to the end of flowering (Zadok GS 69).
Barley	Brown rust Ramularia leaf and awn spot Scald

Mixing

Add the required amount directly into the partly filled spray tank with agitation operating. Complete filling and maintain agitation until spraying is complete. DO NOT leave spray mix standing overnight in the spray tank.

Compatibility

Revystar Fungicide is compatible with most commonly used fungicides (*e.g.* Comet[®]), insecticides, herbicides (*e.g.* Granstar[®], Starane[®]Xtra, or Duplosan[®]KV) and growth regulators (*e.g.* Cycocel[®], Moddus[®], or Terpal[®]). All tank mixes should be used immediately after preparation.

Rainfall

Revystar Fungicide is rain fast once dried on the crop.



Withholding Periods

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the Food Notice: Maximum Residue Levels for Agricultural Compounds.

Cereal grain and straw/stubble: DO NOT harvest or graze within 42 days of last application. Cereal green feed/silage: allow 28 days between last application and introduction of stock for grazing or cutting for silage.
