Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills. Call the Emergency Accident Services: Dial 111. Spill or leak Use personal protective clothing. Avoid contact with the skin, eyes and clothing. Do not breathe vapour/spray. Prevent further spillage. Collect spillage with suitable absorbent material (e.g. sand, sawdust, general-purpose binder, kieselguhr). Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings. Place spilled product and absorbed material in a sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. Fire Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus and chemical-protective clothing. Extinguish fires with water spray, dry powder, foam, carbon dioxide. Keep containers cool by spraying with water if exposed to fire. In case of fire and/or explosion do not breathe fumes. Collect contaminated extinguishing water separately, do not allow to reach sewage or effluent systems. Dispose of fire debris and contaminated extinguishing water in accordance with official regulations. **FIRST AID** If Swallowed: Immediately rinse mouth and then drink 200-300 ml of water, seek medical attention. If in Eyes: Immediately wash affected eyes for at least 15 minutes under running water with eyelids held open, consult an eye specialist. If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. If Inhaled: Keep patient calm, remove to fresh air, seek medical attention STORAGE AND SEGREGATION Storage: Store in the closed, original container, out of direct sunlight in a locked-up, dry, well-ventilated area, building or room, as cool as possible, away from children, animals, feed or foodstuffs.
