Q	Why use Zampro	A	Zampro is a dual active ingredient formulation offering lasting control and better resistance management
Q	Onion and potato diseases controlled	A	Onion downy mildew Potato late blight
Q	Product type	A	Systemic fungicide with translaminar, preventative and anti-sporulant control
Q	Fungicide group	A	Group 45 – Quinone outside Stigmatellin Inhibitors (QoSI) Group 40 – Carboxylic Acid Amides (CAA)
Q	Active ingredients	A	Ametoctradin (300 g/L) Dimethomorph (225 g/L)
Q	Formulation	A	Suspension concentrate
Q	Pack size	A	5 L (Agrecovery friendly)
Q	Application rate	A	800 mL/ha (onions and potatoes)
Q	Adjuvants	A	Always apply with a suitable spreading/penetrating adjuvant
Q	Rainfastness	A	1 hour
Q	Compatibility	A	Can be mixed with most commonly used fungicides and insecticides
Q	Resistance management	A	Onions and potatoes: Make no more than 4 applications per season and no more than 3 consecutive applications. Alternate with a fungicide from another mode of action group.
Q	Withholding period	A	14 days before harvest (Consult with your exporter for advice regarding use on export crops)
