Belanty Quick Fire Fact Sheet APPLES AND PEARS

Q	Pipfruit diseases controlled?	A	Black spot in apples and pears and powdery mildew in apples
Q	Product type?	A	Systemic fungicide with protectant and curative activity
Q	Mode-of-Action group?	A	FRAC Group 3, Demethylation Inhibitors (DMI)
Q	Active ingredient?	A	Mefentrifluconazole
Q	Formulation?	A	75 g/L suspension concentrate
Q	Pack size?	A	10 L plastic Ecopack (eligible for Agrecovery)
Q	Application rate?	A	80 mL/100 L, full dilute application. For concentrate spraying adjust rate accordingly.
Q	Adjuvant?	A	Not required
Q	Rainfastness?	A	Once dry on the crop
Q	Compatibility?	A	Compatible with most commonly used fungicides, insecticides and plant growth regulators
Q	Tank mixing?	A	Always tank mix with a fungicide from another mode of action group
Q	Resistance management?	A	Do not make more than two consecutive applications or apply more than four times per season
Q	Withholding period?	A	Apply up to 35 days pre-harvest (check with your exporter). For nil detectable residues apply no later than 80% petal fall.
Q	Grazing?	A	Do not allow stock to graze within treated orchards until after harvest (no slaughter withholding period applies)
Q	Buffer zones?	A	5 m from waterbodies (30 m downwind)

 Grape diseases controlled?	 Powdery mildew
 Product type?	 Systemic fungicide with protectant and curative activity
 Mode-of-Action group?	 FRAC Group 3, Demethylation Inhibitors
 Active ingredient?	 Mefentrifluconazole
 Formulation?	 75 g/L suspension concentrate
 Pack size?	 10 L plastic Ecopack (eligible for Agrecovery)
 Application rate?	 80 mL/100 L, full dilute application. For concentrate spraying adjust rate accordingly.
 Adjuvant?	 Not required
 Rainfastness?	 Once dry on the crop
 Compatibility?	 Compatible with most commonly used fungicides, insecticides and plant growth regulators
 Tank mixing?	 Always tank mix with a fungicide from another mode of action group or alternate groups between applications
 Resistance management ?	 Do not use more than two Belanty applications per season (check with your exporter)
 Withholding period?	 Apply no later than pre-bunch closure (E-L 31) (nil detectable residues in wine)
 Leaf plucking?	 A 6-month slaughter withholding period must be observed after stock have been removed from the vineyard
 Grazing?	 Do not allow stock to graze within treated vineyards until after harvest
