Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills. Accident Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111. Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, half face-piece respirator with combined dust and vapour cartridge, full length Spill or leak clothing and PVC gloves. Adsorb spilled product and place in a sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal. Fire Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away. **FIRST AID** Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor If Swallowed: If in Eyes: Wash affected eyes for at least 15 minutes under running water with eyelids held open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Get medical attention. If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin/hair with plenty of running water. Do NOT scrub the skin. If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell. STORAGE AND SEGREGATION Storage: Store in the closed, original container, out of direct sunlight in a locked-up, dry, well-ventilated area, building or room, as cool as possible, away from children, animals, feed or foodstuffs. AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered.
