### EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 944 955

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills. <b>Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Use personal protective clothing. Avoid contact with the skin, eyes and clothing. Do not breathe vapour/spray. Prevent further spillage. Collect spillage with suitable absorbent material (e.g. sand, sawdust, general-purpose binder, kieselguhr). Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings. Place spilled product and absorbed material in a sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish warehouse fires with water spray, dry powder, foam, carbon dioxide. Keep containers cool by spraying with water if exposed to fire. During a fire, toxic fumes may be released. Keep non-involved persons away. Contain run-off. Collect contaminated extinguishing water separately, do not allow to reach sewage or effluent systems. Dispose of fire debris and contaminated extinguishing water in accordance with official regulations.

### FIRST AID

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Do not induce vomit. Immediately rinse mouth and then drink 200-300 ml of water, seek medical attention. For advice contact the <b>National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766)</b> or a doctor.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Wash affected eyes for at least 15 minutes under running water with eyelids held open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.

### STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

**Storage:** Store in the closed, original container, out of direct sunlight in a locked-up, dry, well-ventilated area, building or room, as cool as possible, away from children, animals, feed or foodstuffs.

**AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS:** When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current standard NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals or the HSNO Regulations.

<b>Segregation:</b> In store separate by at least 5 metres, on transport separate by at least 3 metres, in both cases horizontally. On vehicles, a segregation device may be used: Check the Land Transport Rule Dangerous Goods, Rule 45001 for additional information. Sea transport may require additional segregation. Refer to NZS5433 Sea Segregation for details.
