Tanker/Vehicle Accident		Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111									
Spill or leak	further s containe	Do not breathe vapour/spray. Use personal protective clothing. Avoid contact with the skin, eyes and clothing. Prevent further spillage and contain. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Absorb spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.									
Fire	fumes m	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water fog, dry powder or foam. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.									
FIRST AID											
If Swallowed:		Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.									
If in Eyes:		Hold eyelids open and rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical advice/attention.									
If on Skin:		Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin thoroughly with soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin. If irritation persists get medical attention.									
If Inhaled:	Remove	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical attention.									
STORAGE AND SEGREGATION											
Storage : Store in original container, tightly closed, in a well ventilated area, as cool as possible, out of direct sunlight, and <u>under lock and key</u> . Avoid temperatures below 0°C and above 35°C. Keep away from fertiliser, seeds, food and feedstuffs.
